› Abstract Preparation:

Abstracts MUST be in English and may not exceed 600 words. Please follow the submission instructions on the AAAR abstracts submission website: <http://aarabstracts.com/2018IAC/>.

› **Co-Author Approval:** Ensure that all co-authors approve the abstract and its potential presentation.

› **Abstract Submissions to any of the Special Symposia or Topical Areas are Welcome.**

› **The Deadline for Submissions is Thursday, February 1, 2018. Note that this is a firm deadline—THERE WILL BE NO EXTENSIONS. DO NOT EXPECT LATE BREAKING POSTERS.**

› **Abstract Receipt Confirmation:** You will receive an email confirmation immediately following the submission of your abstract. If you do not receive a confirmation for your abstract within 24 hours, or if you have questions, please email: support@AAARabstracts.com

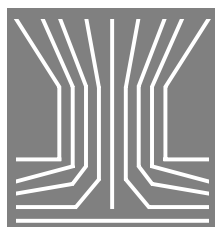
